 Think of ANI like a heart surgeon—it's an expert in one area but can't solve unrelated problems.

 Unlike AGI, ANI can't think, reason, or learn beyond its specific task.

- ✓ **Designed for One Purpose** – ANI is trained for a **single function**.
- ✓ **Extremely Efficient** – Performs its task **faster and more accurately than humans**.
- ✓ **Relies on Training Data** – ANI needs **large amounts of data** to work properly.
